

How kyngis of the blys shalde be made.
Ift the kyng oure souereyne lord Writeth
oure leteris vñ to certeyne squyres of his
zelme and desirynge them for to make
them ready for to receyue the hys and worshypfull
ordir of knyghtode at hys festis of the yere or at
suche tyme as it liketh the kyng for to desire them
for to come. ¶ The enyng of the day of the feste
all the squyres that schall be made kyngis ther
schall come all to gedir vñ to the kyngis walys
and then the stans of the kyngis hons schall mete
with hem and bryng hem vp in to the kyngis
presence. and then schall the kyngis seruer goo vñ
to the kechyn for his mete and all the squyres w
hem that schall be made kyngis for eche on of
then schall bere a dresse and they schall serue the
kyng hit of the firste course and When the kyng
is serued then schall the gentilmen wþers bryng
hem alle to gedir in to ther chambur. then they shall
hane ther seruice in to ther chambur and dyne alle
to gedir and when they hane dynd then schall
the gentilman wþher come in to the syde Cham
bur and asynce eyn squyer his place for his bedde
and for his bayne and when the kyng hath dynd
then schall he sent be the kyngis comandement
certeyne squyres of his housholde to awarde vpon
hem that schall be made kyngis and be ther
seruauntes and chamburleynes. ¶ Then schall

the kyngis barboure come and hane all the squyres
and eyn squyer schall pape for his berde shawinge
xx. d. and eyn squyer schall ordeyne for his bayne
xxviij. ellis of lymayn clothe and that schall the
kyngis barboure hane for his fee. ¶ Then schall
the syde squyres goo vñ to ther bayne and all
that abillment the sergaunt of the chaundre shall
hane for his fee and when they be in ther bayne
then schall the heraldis of armis goo vñ to the
kyng and lete him hane knollege that the squy
res bene in ther bayne. then schall the kyng coman
de the stewarde of his houſe wþ other lordis and
knyghtis for to goo vñ to the squyres and yene them
ther charge as they sate in ther bayne. ¶ Then
schall the stewarde come wþ all the lordis and
knyghtis the kyngis mynstrellis and heraldis of
armis before them vñ to the chambur doore and then
the lordis entir in to the chambur wþ the heraldis
for to yene them ther charge as they bene in the
bayne saynige in this wise. ¶ Broþur the kyng
oure souereyne lord wþt that ye take this hys
and worshypfull ordir vñ on your the whiche þ as
a kyngist declare vñ to yow certeyne pouynis that
longth vñ to this hys and worshypfull ordir of
knyghtode ye schall loue god abone all thunge and
be fedfaste in the feste and sustene the churche and
ye schall be trewe vñ to yourre souereyne lord
and trewe of yourre wordis and promyses sekirtee in

that ought to be kept. also ye schall susteine wydows
in ther right at every tyme they wol require you
and maydeups in ther virginitie and helpe hem
socour hem wth powre good that for lack of god
they be not mysgonewyd. Also ye schall stee i noo
plase wher that eyn judgement schulde be geyn
wrongefuly ayens eyn body to powre knowleche
Also ye schall not suffir uoo murdereis nor exces
ness of the kyngis peccat. Wth in the come re
ye dwelle but wth powre power ye schall lete
doo take them and put them in to the handis of
justice and that they be punysshid as the kyngis
lasse wolt. and then ye schall purce your hande
in to the bayue and take up Warre and make a
crosse up on his lyfe shuldr before and behynde
and kisse it and say in nomine p[re]dicti e[st] God sendt
you as moche worshipe as eyn had eyn of your
kyngis and thus muste doo all the lordis knyghtis
vnto every squyer as he sitteth i the bayue

¶ Then they schall goo one of ther bayues
in to ther beddis and then they schall axist and
make them redy in hermytis array of Colchestr
inner and the sergant of the kyngis chaundre
schall haue all the beddis the whiche bene thus
arrayed. a matras a payre of blakens a payre
of shens a Coursire and a coulid of worlde and
a clooth of golde up on that and a reed tapur of
worlde at his beddis heed hysgrunge on the he

¶ Than they schall goo alle to gedre in to the cha
pelle and bee in ther preperis till in the monyng
vn to viij. of the clokke. than they schall haue
a masse of the holy goste and then they schall of
fer a tapur and a peyne stkyng in the tapur as nye
the hysgt as it may resonably. When masse is
done then they schall goo vn to ther chambres
and change hem and the kyngis wayte schall
haue alle ther wachyng garmentis. ¶ Than
they schall change them in to a nothir arrayment
fyrste they schall putte vp on them boubantis w^t
blak hossis chasen. as a red core of red tartaryn
and a white cor. a gyrd aboute hem and the gyrd
may haue 1.00 bofis. then he muste haue
a white coysse w^t on his leed and then a man
teff of red tartaryn purfled aboute wth
crayn and that muste be putte abone
hem and a white lase muste be in the seyde
manest before at the breste wth a peyre of
white glonyss knyt in the seyde lase. ¶ Then
the seruantes and chambreynes that bene aby
nd to awarte vp on them schall take ther swerdis
and the stabert schall be whote leon wth onte
any bofis and a payre of giske spors hangyng
up on the hiltis of the same swerde and the seyde
seruantes and chambreynes schall bere the seyde
swerde wth the spors before them. ¶ Then
they schall come dowlne and take ther hoxsis

and ther horsis schall be arayde in this wise the
fadre muste be blak and bordred aboute hem whiche
ledre and the brider muste be blak with a crosse of
latoun henginge in the frante of the horse and
a partrell of the same silke and the marchall of
Engelonde schall haue all ther horsis for his fee
A Then they schall alystre and come in to the
kyngis presence with ther swordis borne before
them and makunge ther obeysance. then they
schall come emp to the kyng. then schall two
kyngistis take the sporis of the sworde and doo
hem on ther hestis. then schall the kyng gy-
de his sworde aboute him. then the squyer put-
teth bothe his thumbris with in the las of his
mantel and syfis up his armys onyr his heid
then the kyng putteth bothe his handis with
in his armys and takis him aboute the necke
with bothe his handis and kisst hem and pluk-
kis hem by the necke and sayes vnto hem. say-
es bon chenalcere then he bukys downe and
standis by till the kyng hath made hem alle
than they schall be lade vnto the chapele
with kyngistis. **W**hen they come in to the
chapele empyn before the kyng aut. then they shall
vngird hem and leye his sworde up on the
alter and then bukys downe and ley his hande
up on the aut. then the deen or on for hem
that is asynd for to say in this wise. Be this

holi aut. that oure lordis body is mynistrid on ye
schall susteyne the churche and kepe this kyng and
worshipfull ordre that ye haue takyn vp on your
ye be. **A**nd when they be goynge out of the
chapele then schall the kyngis mayst coos mere
with hem at the dore and he schall say vnto
them in this wise. **I** as the kyngis mayst coos
come at this tyme to lette your haue knowlege
what is myne office. fe myne office is yf ye be
vntrewe to yourre souvereyne lord or oon ayens
this kyng and worshipfull ordre that ye haue
takyn myne office is that y. muste myste of
yourre hele be the small of yourre leggis and
derfore I clayme yourre sporis the whiche I pray
you remembre this in yourre mynde and penne
your grace to kepe this kyng and worshipfull ordre
and penne your as moche worshipe as emp had
emp of yourre kyng. **T**hen they schall be
bronght in to the halle then the kyng comyth
in to the halle and wasshis and is sette then schall
all the newe made kyngistis wasshe and sette at
a side bordre and when the kyng is fyd then
all the halle schall be fyd but the newe made
kyngistis schall ete noo mere and when the kyng
is fyd of the laste course then the herawdes schall
cye the kyngis largesse in fourre plasis in the
halle. then the herawdes schall come in ageyne
and cye larges in two plasis of the halle of the

newe made kyngis and when the kyng shal
dynid. then they schall goo in to ther chambres
and doo of ther arrayment and that the heaw
dis shal hane for ther fee. Then they shal
doo vp on them longe blise gornis and it
miste be purfled aboue with ermynd and a whi
last of silke vntis golde in the costis miste be
pynd a pyn vp on his lyte schuldr and a hood
of the same purfled aboue of the shapre as ba
chesers of lare han and the hood miste be
capter aboue his neck and the hood and the tyme
pynd to geor vp on the lyte schuldr and
then they schall goo alle to geor vñ to the kyng
and when they come in to his presence on that
say for them alle in this wise. most kyng and
excellent and most myngyn pync oure souvereyn
lorde we thanke you of this kyng and worshyp
full ordyn that ye haue gyne vñ to vs and we
as your lege men schall be redy at your
comandement. then they schall borsome them
downe alle at onys and arise and goo ther way
then they schall goo in to ther chambres and
change hem and all these gornis and hode
the sergant of the kyngis chambres schall
hane for his fee. And then all the newe made
kyngis may doo what them likis for all to
done and endid.

To grafe aqua poposita

Take a handfull of Rosemary a good boote
of nutmegges a handfull of Redde myrtle
a handfull of Rose gal. a handfull of
tyme halfe a handfull of Sage vi godes
spoff wch i mynt almane pomyrall gal.
a handfull of Rose bounde in a boote of magneton
a boote of Redde myrtle wch payed and bissell
cynamome amersende byssell than take in gal
of good ale and take hit the soffred wch
crys alle and put them in a pott and set the
apon the fire and let them stande full two
dayes begyn to boyle & then take them from the
fire and appon the pott a lymett and stoff
it into wch spafe that they come none way
out. So to kepe it wth a softe strope no
redo aquabito

1 gallone of ale and a gallone of wffe of
red wine
